The Grand Staircase

Russian interior designer Theodore Komisajevski opted for an Italian Gothic style. Although the building was originally created as a theatre, this style was traditionally employed for the design of churches. # The Main Auditorium

Despite seeing a period of neglect, the illustrious theatre has played host to many musical acts that went on to become superstars, including Buddy Holly (1958), Roy Orbison and the Beatles (1963). The Hall of Mirrors even served as a casino for a time. In the 1960s, it sadly went the way of many cinemas, hosting bingo nights and, eventually, the popular game replaced movies altogether and the theatre became a full time bingo hall. Now, we return triumphantly to the glory days, uncovering the theatre's former splendour!

# The Main Auditorium

With a seating capacity of nearly 2500, Ebenezer Building is a venue on a truly grand scale. Period features have been retained and new work is sensitive to the original styling, even down to the interior doors, which have been resupplied by the same manufacturer who made them nearly 100 years ago. The Hall of Mirrors

Regarding the exuberant design of the theatre, Theodore Komisarjevsky declared: "Houses of worship were not intended to be like cold dismal drill halls or mortuaries. They were not meant to depress people. The aim of ecclesiastical architecture was to attract people, to offer them not only rows of pews in which to say their prayers but romantic relaxation and artistic pleasure amid surrounds of hope, colourful beauty and harmony." And now, this ideal can be fulfilled as Ebenezer Building once more fills up with people.

# The Hall of Mirrors
